

Internship report guidelines

3000-word essay

- a) Name and address of the student
- b) Name and address of the internship sponsor and the contact person
- c) Duration and time period of the internship
- d) Short description of the organization/company and the department in which the internship takes place.

Points a-d should not be longer than a quarter of the whole essay!

- e) Description of goals, given-duties, activity areas and processes.
- f) Description of the skills, knowledge and theory learnt or acquired through the M.A. program that were used during the internship. (Here should be the main focus of the essay!)
- g) Description of the experiences, knowledge, proficiencies, handling competencies and experiences that were used to resolve the duties given and that make sense for future professional practice. Description of the work-relationship during the internship with the internship provider (support etc.).
- h) Evaluation of the internship (activities, experiences etc.) in light of the original goals (see f) and the actual development of internship-related responsibilities/learning process.

Replacement paper for those NOT doing the internship or internship report

3000-word essay

Here are the details concerning the replacement paper (professional paper), if you are already a professional and if you have the permission from the university not to do an internship. The following points must be addressed in the replacement paper:

- a) Name and address of the student
- b) Name and address of the organization you are working for / with
- c) Duration and time since you are working with this company
- d) Short description of the organization/company and the department in which the internship takes place
- e) Short description of your work area, activities

Points a-e should not be much longer than a quarter of the whole essay!

- g) What are the links (if any) between visual and/or media anthropology and your professional domain?
- h) How could your professional domain be enriched (changed) from Visual and/or Media Anthropology methods/content?

Points g and h should be the main focus of the essay!
